The Trustee Board is the corporate leadership body responsible for the overall control of College governance, resources, its assets, all financial matters and risk. It has overall responsibility for the corporate strategy that enables delivery of the profession priorities and policies of Council. Trustees have statutory duties, including personal liability for ensuring RCGP is run in accordance with Charity law. It oversees the work of three trading companies – RCGP Enterprises Ltd, RCGP Conferences Ltd and RCGP International Ltd, each of which has a Board of Directors.

The Chair of the Trustee Board and four of the trustees are elected by Council, three are Council Officers and four are independent trustees appointed for their expertise in leadership and delivery. Trustees are volunteers and are not paid for this role.



## Council

Council is the policy making and representative body and is responsible for determining standards, strategy and priorities for the profession. There are 75 seats which are filled by members from a mix of nationally elected positions, faculty representatives and ex-officio appointments. This includes the President elected by all members as the ceremonial lead for College.

Council Officers are elected by Council and each have specific areas of leadership responsibility on which to guide College decision-making on professional matters.
